- **Due to the nature of physiotherapy assessment, it may be necessary for you to expose the area being assessed, or for the area to be touched, including the joints above and below. Signing this statement confirms you are happy for this to occur with the knowledge you can refuse at any time. When a treatment plan is discussed the nature, risk and intended benefit will be explained. If you are not clear or comfortable with the suggested plan then at any time you can ask about the alternatives, including no treatment at all. Signature below confirms you are happy to consent to the initial assessment. Follow up appointments will undergo “inferred consent” where your attendance and participation infers you are happy for treatment, again refusal at any time is possible. Personal data is collected at initial appointment, this data will not be shared with any third party unless it relates to treatment and consent is obtained. - **I agree for my anonymised data to be used in an ongoing clinical audit (until such a time as I notify you otherwise**
- **Children under the age of 16 must be treated with an adult, in the case of legal minors aged 16/17 discretion is used to decide whether they have the capacity to consent to treatment. Chaperoning adults should sign below to confirm consent.
